## **Director's Report**

- 1. Museum Pass Update The passes are being used a lot! In August 50 passes were used. So far this year 154 passes have been used. In comparison, last year the total was 158.
- 2. The brochures have been printed and displayed. The cost for 250 brochures is \$128. The Friends need to reimburse Hope this amount as she paid for them.
- 3. Fundraising for the Library Expansion Fundraising has begun. A bank account has been set up and a fundraising committee is working on outreach. There is a donation jar at the library. If any Friend would like to host an "expansion party" let the committee know. There is money available to pay for the invitations and snacks.
- 4. Grant potential The NH Charitable Foundation has a major grant available for IT and Library Tech which can be geared toward an expansion grant. This grant is available to non-profits so the Friends' EIN number and 5013c info will be needed. Dan will do the work to apply for this grant.
