Fundraising Committee meeting 10/24/23

Dan has been receiving patrons that have been under the misconception that the library expansion would cost 17 million. Other patrons have remarked that posting shouldn't primarily be focused on children's events or insignificant events like knitting.

A new email list/chain needs to be used. A number of people are not receiving emails from the committee.

Updates:

Social Media – We need to develop a consistent and immediate response to negative comments.

- Contact the people that respond and ask them to join us.
- Don't let comments go unanswered.
- Make positive posts.
- Like supportive posts

Hosted Events – Allison's open house on Friday.

Members of the budget committee are not supporting the library expansion. A few member of the budget committee are against the expansion.

The list of grants needs to be reviewed and inclusive of all grants with expected amounts to be given to the Selectboard. Incorrect or random numbers will not be received well by the selectmen. The number of grants on document held by Dan and Sarah do not agree. Dan's list has 7 grants, and the list Sarah has included 4. Both indicate grants could be applied for up to 100k. We need to consolidate the grant list and give a better estimate of what can be expected. Dan will meet with the owner of Jim Trombley plumbing and heating, next week. It was decided that a discussion with Dan Carpenter should wait until after the open house.

A document is needed to approach the businesses in town.
