### **Director's Report**

1. **Museum Passes** - October was another strong month for passes with 12 going out which is better than last Oct. Total so far this year is 219 passes, which breaks last year's total of 199 and is up 26.5% to date.

  The need for increased staffing and resources continue to be apparent. Budget hearing before the Budget Committee is Nov. 21 at 7pm at the Town Hall. The library asked for 8 more hours in staffing and the Select Board compromised to
- 4. **Sisters in Crime** Cathy thanked all who helped with the event and all who came to support the event. Only 6 people in the audience were community members. Others were Friends' members or friends of the authors. Cathy raised the questions of who is our audience and how do we increase attendance.
- 5. **John Rockwood Loon Man** This event is booked for Thurs., Nov. 14th from 6:30-8:00pm. There are flyers and a place to register on the library website. There is a limit of 25 people due to the room size so register ASAP. The cost of the presentation is \$150, payable the day of the talk.
- 6. **Pavilion Fundraising** Discussion about potential donation toward the cause:
  - Cost is \$3600 currently have \$1500-\$1700 in donations so need \$2000
  - Dan has not yet contacted business for donations, but he will do this.
  - Trustees only have taxpayers money. The Book Sale money will go toward the expansion.
  - The cost will increase in the future so this is a good time to do this project.
  - Background on Pavilion It is a "pavilion in a box" that was purchased in Dec. 2021 from grant money that Kathy Growney, previous director, had applied for. The Friends also paid a portion of the cost.
  - Checks should be written to the library with restricted donation for the pavilion noted.
  - If additional money is donated from businesses or individuals the Friends donation will be reduced by that amount.

A motion was made that the Friends donate up to \$2000 for construction and assembly of the pavilion, less donations received for this work.

1st Brenda Beer and 2<sup>nd</sup> Fay - motion passed.
